**ORDER (I) AMENDING EMPLOYEE WAGE ORDER TO INCREASE
CERTAIN CAPS AND (II) AUTHORIZE THE PAYMENT OF THE
AMENDED AMOUNTS TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES**

Upon the motion filed by the above-captioned debtors in possession (the "Debtors") seeking to (i) amend the Wage Order (defined below) to increase the amount of payments that the Debtors were authorized to make to current employees with respect to wages and reimbursement of business-related expenses, and (ii) obtain authority to pay such amended amounts to employees, pursuant to Del. Bankr. L.R. 9013-1(k)(ii); the Court finding that (a) the Court has jurisdiction over these cases pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, (b) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2)(A) and (M), and (c) notice of the Motion was sufficient under the circumstances; the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and it appearing that the relief requested is in the best interests of the Debtors' estates, their creditors and other parties in interest;

IT IS HEREBY FOUND, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. The Order (I) Authorizing the Debtors to (A) Pay Prepetition Wages, Salaries, Commissions, Employee Benefits and Other Compensation; (B) Remit Withholding Obligations; (C) Maintain Employee Benefits Programs and Pay Related Administrative Obligations; and (II) Authorizing Applicable Banks and Other Financial Institutions to Receive, Process, Honor and Pay Certain Checks Presented for Payment and to Honor Certain Fund Transfer Requests [Docket No. 27] (the "Wage Order") is modified to increase the Independent Contractor Cap to \$57,000.
3. The Wage Order is further modified to increase the Expense Cap to \$47,000.
4. The other terms of the Wage Order remain in full force and effect.
