ORDER PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 1121(D) FURTHER EXTENDING DEBTORS' EXCLUSIVE PERIODS IN WHICH TO FILE A CHAPTER 11 PLAN AND SOLICIT VOTES THEREON

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.

Unless otherwise defined herein, all capitalized terms shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Motion.

- 2. The Debtors' exclusive period for filing a chapter 11 plan is hereby extended through and including May 11, 2008. The Debtors' exclusive period for soliciting acceptances thereof is hereby extended through and including July 11, 2008.
- 3. This Order is without prejudice to the Debtors' right to request any further extensions of the Exclusive Periods.
- 4. This Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from the implementation of this Order.
