From my discussions with Microsoft it's becoming clearer what their "version of Windows for handwriting" (which I call "Windows H") really will be. For instance, Jeff Raikes told me that of course they're not thinking this would be to run all the Windows applications, cause they're too big and aren't pen attuned, but it'd be to run a rewritten version of MS Works for Windows (coming out this year) that would be bundled with the Windows H on the Japanese notebook computers.
