
Pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 1871 (b)(2) and (3), when a petit juror is required to attend more than ten (10) days of actual petit jury service (including days of travel) or a grand juror is required to attend more than forty-five (45) days of actual grand jury service (including days of travel), said juror may be paid an additional fee not exceeding \$10.00 more than the attendance fee for each day in excess of the ten (10) days of actually petit jury service or forty-five (45) days of actual grand jury service, unless the presiding judge determines in his or her discretion that such enhanced fees are not appropriate and directs that they not be paid.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that jurors serving in the above entitled case shall receive an

increase of attendance fees of \$10.00 for each day present (or in travel status) in excess of ten (10) days.
