OLE 1.0 - Shipping in WP 5.2 In our press release. Will support OLE 2.0 in next rev Win32s - Will ship WP 6.0 as Win32s product (probably in Q3'93) Windows NT - Issued press release stating support for NT. Will support through Win32s ODBC - WordPerfect was part of IDAPI announce, but should support ODBC also. MAPI - Supporting VIM but will support MAPI also.

GOALS FOR THIS MEETING:

Keep WordPerfect up-to-date and committed to our Systems Strategy (keep resources tied to Windows versus other platforms) (also get feedback on Systems strategy before SDR.)
Get them committed to WOSA (speicifically ODBC and MAPI to begin with) Explore possibility of WordPerfect Office pump for WFW and MsMail. Push for support of OLE 2.0 across all products.

We have been very successful in our dealings with WordPerfect over the last 6 to 9 months. WordPerfect will ship WP 6.0 as a Win32s product. This all hinged on the fact that we needed to provide Win32s OLE 2.0 and Memory Mapped File support. The memory mapped files was a big issue for them since this is what they were doing in NT. WordPerfect for over a year has been saying they'll ship an OS/2 product. I'd guess WP 6.0 will also ship for OS/2 2.0 at the same time as the Win32s version.

WordPerfect was part of the IDAPI announcement. They will provide a driver for their DataPerfect product. This isn't much of an announcement. It's more of just getting the WordPerfect name behind IDAPI. However, they did show a forms product called "InForms for Windows". Their spec for this says they will support multiple data sources. This could either be through ODBC or IDAPI (or support for both). I'm working now to make sure ODBC is included here.

WordPerfect also will support MAPI (along with VIM). They participated in the Windows for Workgroups launch and the workgroup section of the ISV booth at Comdex. We will get them to support MAPI within their applications as well as write a MAPI Service Provider for WordPerfect Office.

Other info:

Just announced purchase of Reference Software this week.

* Rumored to be going public in '93. This would be significant in giving them cash to purchase needed technology.
