1	Allow the WordPerfect, Quattro Pro and Envoy viewers to come up in Netscape's main window, with the Back, Forward, Reload, etc. controls on top.	A	1
2	Include *.wpd and *.evy filters, as well as the default *.htm, in the "List Files of Type" pull-down list in the File Open dialog.	B	14
3	Support UNC pathnames in the File Open dialog.	B	14
4	Support UNC pathnames in "file:" URL's.	B	14
5	Support "bookmarks" in WordPerfect or Envoy documents. This means Netscape would have to have a way of separating the bookmark from the rest of a URL, without having to understand the bookmark, itself, and pass it on to the viewer, so that it could come up, viewing the document at the location specified by the bookmark. Netscape would also need to provide a way for the WordPerfect and Envoy Viewers to add internal hypertext links that they follow, to its Back/Forward history.	B	11
6	Work out a user interface to allow a user to browse hyperlinked documents in Netscape and then indicate, "OK, Here's the page I want." Then, Netscape should exit, and somehow pass the URL of the last page viewed back to the application that launched it.	B	4
7	Cooperate to define a new clipboard format and drag & drop method that preserves hypertext links, including relative ones. It should also support links to a specific cell or range of cells within an HTML 3.0 Table.	B	4
8	Facilitate client-side QuickFinder indexing of every document a user views in the Netscape (including non-HTML), by providing API's to allow menu customization, etc.	B	30
