**NOTICE OF ERRATA WITH RESPECT TO OBJECTION OF CHAPTER 11
TRUSTEE TO SUSE'S MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM THE AUTOMATIC
STAY TO COMPLETE INTERNATIONAL ARBITRATION**

1. On December 15, 2009, Edward N. Cahn, Esq. (the "Chapter 11 Trustee" or "Trustee"), in his capacity as chapter 11 trustee for The SCO Group, Inc. ("SCO Group") and SCO Operations, Inc. ("SCO" and together with SCO Group, the "Debtors"), filed the *Objection of Chapter 11 Trustee to SUSE's Motion For Relief from the Automatic Stay to Complete International Arbitration* [Docket No. 992] (the "Trustee's Objection").

2. Paragraph 19 on page 6 of the Trustee's Objection incorrectly stated that in early 2008 some of Novell's claims were stayed in favor of the SUSE Arbitration. This statement was in error - none of Novell's claims were stayed in favor of the SUSE Arbitration. This notice of errata is filed to correct that statement.

3. Accordingly, find attached hereto as **Exhibit A** a revised version of page 6 of the Trustee's Objection, which is deemed to be included in the original filing. Attached hereto as **Exhibit B** is a blackline of page 6 of the Trustee's Objection marked against the previously filed version.
