ORDER GRANTING ABANDONMENT OF PROPERTY OF THE ESTATE

Upon consideration of the notice (the "Abandonment Notice")² of Edward N. Cahn, Esq. (the "Trustee"), in his capacity as Chapter 11 Trustee for the above-captioned debtors (collectively, the "Debtors"), pursuant to section 554 of title 11 of the United States Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101 et seq. (the "Bankruptcy Code") and Rule 6007 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the "Bankruptcy Rules"), of the Debtors' intention to abandon property of the estate and set time for objection; and the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Abandonment Notice and the relief requested therein in accordance with 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and the Court having found that good and sufficient cause exists for granting the Abandonment Notice and the relief requested therein; and it appearing that the relief requested in the Abandonment Notice is appropriate in the context of these cases and is in the best interests of the Debtors' estates and all other parties-in-interest; and it appearing that service of the Abandonment Notice on parties who have requested service of papers pursuant to Bankruptcy

ORDERED that the Trustee is hereby authorized to take any actions reasonably necessary to effectuate the abandonment approved herein; and it is further

ORDERED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction over all matters arising from or related to the interpretation and implementation of this Order.
